B.V.Sc. & A.H

Duration The duration of B.V.Sc. & A.H degree course is spread over five and half complete professional years including a compulsory rotating internship of one year duration

Admission Procedure

Admission to B.VSc. and AH in India is by two ways.

NEET Score (VCI)

State Owned Entrances (Counselling by individual States)

The Veterinary Council of India VCI admits on the basis of NEET.

NEET (National Eligibility cum Entrance Test)

The selection of candidates for admission to B.V.Sc. & A.H. degree course under 15% All-India Quota shall be applicable to the recognized Veterinary Colleges in India (except from Jammu & Kashmir State).
