The duration of B.V.Sc. & A.H degree course is spread over five and half complete professional years including a compulsory rotating internship of one year duration

Entrance Exam

Admission to BVSc and AH in India is by two ways. Through State Govt and by Central govt (VCI). THE candidate domicile of state can admit into BVSC by +2 marks and CET exam. The VCI admits on the basis of NEET.

NEET (National Eligibility cum Entrance Test)
